

Your journal can be either handwritten or typed. You should have a separate journal entry for each chapter of the novel. Label each entry with the date and chapter. Each entry should have two components:

2. Questions

- Write at least 3 *questions* you had while reading each chapter.
- Only one question, at most, can be question that clarifies the plot of text. Strive to develop questions that explore the deeper issues of the text.
- You do not need to write a response to each question.

2. Quotations and Reflections

- As you read each chapter select one quote (per chapter) that you believe is intriguing, powerful, or in some way central to story.
- Carefully recopy the quote exactly as it appears in the novel.
- For each quote write 3-5 sentences about why you chose it—describe how and why it is important to the text and/or how it deepens your understanding of the novel.
