



# Spanish 3rd Quarter



◆ In the 3rd Quarter, students in grades 1-2 will explore classroom space as they learn Spanish school supplies and verbs for using them. It will also be the season for music, games, and written activities centered on a variety of fruits!

◆ Grades 3-4 students will be ready to forecast the climate in Spanish using weather conditions, dates, and seasons. With food vocabulary and the verbs *comer* and *beber* (eat and drink), students will discuss with classmates their fantasy fare.

◆ Grades 5-8 students will recite their class schedule in Spanish as they gain vocabulary for class subjects and places in the school. Their ability to dialogue continues to grow as they conjugate singular and plural -ar verbs.
